1. Match & Training Filming Support

- Assist with filming Academy fixtures and selected training sessions across Foundation, Youth Development and Professional Development phases.
- Ensure all footage is captured clearly and uploaded within agreed timelines.
- Support the organisation and storage of Academy video content.

2. Video Coding & Clip Preparation

- Assist in coding matches and training sessions using club analysis software.
- Tag key technical, tactical and positional moments as directed by Academy coaching staff.
- Produce individual player clips, unit clips and team review footage for post-match learning.
- Help maintain coding templates and performance databases.

3. Coach & Player Analysis Support

- Support the preparation of pre-match and post-match analysis presentations.
- Assist coaches in creating age-appropriate visual feedback for players.
- Contribute to individual player review resources linked to development targets.
- Help players access and review video footage to encourage reflection and learning.

4. Opposition & Research Assistance

- Support with basic opposition analysis and video compilation where required.
- Assist in identifying key tactical themes, strengths and areas for exploitation.
- Conduct football research projects to support Academy coaching interventions.
